- Social security card
- Proof of veteran's preference, if applicable (e.g., DD- 214)
- Resume (although not required, it may assist in determining eligibility)

*Because TechBoost is a federally funded program, age and eligibility to work in the US must be verified and documented. If you are missing anything listed above or need help, please contact us for further assistance as you will need to have these documents readily available to upload in Step 2.

Step 2:
